A. O'Reilly Auto Parts – Chairman David Taylor stated O'Reilly Auto Parts is proposing to put a building out on lower Allegheny Boulevard. Chairman David Taylor stated they intend to build about a 7000 square foot building in this lot that they are acquiring. Josh Schripsema with Simon CRE stated he is representing Simon Commercial Real Estate as well as O'Reilly Auto Parts. Josh Schripsema stated they are excited to bring an O'Reilly Auto Parts to the Brookville community. Josh Schripsema stated we are proposing a 7200 square foot retail store. Josh Schripsema stated we will be subdividing two properties, and taking 180 feet of frontage on the highway as well. Josh Schripsema stated there is potential for about one and a half to two million dollars in sales tax revenue. Josh Schripsema stated they are in the process of getting their PennDOT Highway Occupancy Permit. After some discussion, Member Bob Radaker made a motion to approve the O'Reilly Auto Parts Plan contingent on Solicitor review, zoning

review, stormwater review, and Highway Occupancy Permit (HOP) review; seconded by Vice-Chairman Ed Richards. Motion carried 4-0.
